White, Green,

Body

Round 1: Sc 5 in MR (5)

Round 2: *2 sc in each sc* around (10)

Round 3: *sc, 2 sc in next sc* around (15)

Round 4: *sc 2, 2 hdc in next stitch, sc 2, 2 sc in next* twice then sc 2, 2 hdc in next stitch (20)

Round 5: sc 2, 2 hdc in next stitch, 2 hdc in next stitch, sc 16 (22)

Round 6: sc 3, dec across next 2 stitches, sc 17(21)

Round 7: sc, dec, dec, sc 16 (19)

Round 8: *sc in each sc* around (19)

Round 9: sc, dec, sc 16 (18)

Round 10: sc , dec, sc 8, dec, sc 5 (16)

Round 11: *sc, dec* around, sc in last stitch in round (11)

Rounds 12-15: sc in each sc* around (11)

Round 16: *dec* around (5)

Nose

Round 1: sc 6 in MR (6)

Round 2: *2 sc in each sc* around (12)

Round 3: *sc, 2 sc in next sc* around (18)

Round 4: *sc in each sc* around (18)

Round 5: sc 2, dec across next 2sc, sc 7, dec across next 2 sc, sc 5 (16)

Round 6:*sc in each sc* around (16)

Round 7: *sc 2, dec* around (12)

Round 8: *sc, dec* around (8)

Round 9: sc 4, leave remaining stitches unworked
F/o.

White Belly (chain 1 after each row)

Row 1: ch 5, sc in 2nd chain from hook and remaining chains (4)

Rows 2-4: *sc in each sc* across (4)

Row 5: 2 sc in first sc, sc 2, 2 sc in last sc (6)

Rows 6-10: *sc in each sc* across (6)

Row 11: sc 2, dec, sc 2 (5)

Row 12: *sc in each sc* across (5)

Row 13: dec, sc, dec (3)

Row 14: sc, dec (2)

Row 15: *sc in each sc* across (2)

F/o.

Arms (make 2)

Round 1: sc 4 in MR

Rounds 2-3: *sc in each sc* around (4)

F/o.

Cheeks (make 2)

Round 1: sc 5 in MR

Round 2: *2 sc in each sc* around (10)

Round 3: *sc in each sc* around (10)

F/o.

Back Bumps

ch 7

2 dc in 1st, slip stich, 2 dc, slip, 2 dc, slip

F/o.

Shell

Round 1: sc 8 in MR (red) change color to white

Rounds 2-3: *sc in each sc* around (8)

F/o.



Shoes (make 2)

Round 1: sc 8 in MR (gold)

Round 2: *sc 3, 2 sc in next stitch* around (10) change color to white

Round 3: *sc in each sc* around (10)

Round 4: *sc 3, dec* around (8)

F/o.

Feet (make 2)

Round 1: sc 5 in MR, do not join

F/o.

Assembly

Attach the snout to the body with fastened off side to the body. Look at pictures for placement. Sew the white belly piece around underneath the snout, making sure the placement of the smaller end matches with the tail. Sew arms on beside the white belly. The white cheeks should then be sewn on and shaped a little to fit in the space above the arm and beside the snout. Attach the shoes' orange side to the body (this side has the hole). After attaching shoe, place the foot with the fastened off side closest to the foot. The arch of the MR should be facing up. Look at pictures for placement. Attach the back bumps and shell straight down the back. I would start with the shell and then attach the other part after shell is in place in order to make sure you have enough room.
