Round 1: Sc 6 in mr

Round 2: *2 sc in each sc* around (12)

Round 3: *Sc, 2 sc in next sc* around (18)

Round 4: *Sc in each sc* around in back loop (18)

Round 5-10: *Sc in each sc* around (18)

F/o. first leg only! Do not fasten of 2nd leg, sc into f/o. stitch of 1st leg and around, continue onto 2nd leg and sc around (36)

Round 11-12: *Sc in each sc* around (36)

Round 13: Sc 8, dec across next 2 sc, sc 16, dec across next 2 sc, sc 8 (34)

Round 13: *sc in each sc* around (34)

Round 14: Sc 6, dec across next 2 sc, sc 18, dec across next 2 sc, sc 6 (32)

Round 15: *sc in each sc* around (32)

Round 16: Sc 6, dec across next 2 sc, sc 16 across next 2 sc, dec, sc 6 (30)

Round 17: *sc in each sc* around (30)

Round 18: Sc 4, dec across next 2 sc, sc 18 dec across next 2 sc, sc 4 (28)

Round 19: *sc in each sc* around (28)

Round 20: Sc 5, dec across next 2 sc, sc 14, dec across next 2 sc, sc 5 (26)

Round 21: *Sc 4, dec across next 2 sc* around, sc in last 2 stitches(22)

Round 22: *Sc 5, dec across next 2 sc* around, sc in last stitch (19)

Round 23: Sc 3, dec, sc 2, dec, sc 2, dec, sc 2, dec, sc 2 (15)

Round 24: *Sc 3, dec across next 2 sc* around (12)

Round 25-26: *sc in each sc* around (12)



Round 11: *Sc 2, dec across next 2 sc* around (24)

Hat triangles (dark green-make 4)

Row 1: Ch 11, sc in 2nd chain from hook and each chain across (10) ch 1, turn

Row 2: Skip first sc, sc across (9) ch 1, turn

Row 3: Skip first sc, sc across (8) ch 1, turn

Row 4: Skip first sc, sc across (7) ch 1, turn

Row 5: Skip first sc, sc across (6) ch 1, turn

Row 6: Skip first sc, sc across (5) ch 1, turn


Row 7: Skip first sc, sc across (4) ch 1, turn

Row 8: Skip first sc, sc across (3) ch 1, turn

Row 9: Skip first sc, sc across (2) ch 1, turn

Row 10: Skip first sc, sc across (1)

Hat corners (dark green-make 4)

Row 1: Ch 2, sc in 2nd chain front hook, chain 3, sc in 2nd chain from hook and next chain, chain 2, sc in 2nd chain from hook

Large Spikes (Dark green-make 6)

Round 1: Sc 4 in MR

Round 2: *2 sc in each sc* around (8)

F/o.

Medium Spikes (Dark green-make 5)

Round 1: sc 4 in MR


Round 2: *sc, 2 sc in next sc* around (6)

F/o.

Small Spikes (Dark green-make 11)

Round 1: sc 3 in MR slip stitch to 1st sc

F/o.



Assembly

The hat triangles need to be either slip stitched together or sewn together with yarn needle. All fastened off parts should be located at the top point of the hat. Sew the finished hat to the top of the head. The hat corners should be sewn on at the crease where you sewed the hat triangles together closest to the face.

The large spikes go on the bottom of both legs (2 each) and the front section of the body (2). The medium spikes go at the farthest parts of the arm (2 each), and one above the 2 large spikes on the front of the body. The small spikes go up the arm (2 each), and around the neck (3).

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
